The Course: Indian Valley Country Club

The Indian Valley Creek runs through eight of the 18 holes on this 6,850-yard private course. Built in 1952, the par 72 course was designed by Willam Gordon.

In 2004, a 20-acre practice facility was added. Preceding this was a clubhouse renovation, completed in 2000.

They have been busy the past two years as well, removing 250 trees, while ongoing projects include drainage projects and up-grading and renovating tees and bunkers.

Ray takes great satisfaction accomplishing tasks and projects outside of the norm. If only he didn’t have to deal with the typical Green Committee Meeting that ends only six or seven hours before the next work day begins!
