The Course: Middletown Country Club

Middletown Country Club is nearing its 100th anniversary. Designed in the parkland style by Alexander Findlay, the 18-hole course measures 6,217 yards from the back tees. It is a par 69 that rates 68.4 with a slope of 119.

In 1999, a great deal of work was done to upgrade the course, including the irrigation system. Holes 6 and 7 were rerouted, and the tees on #6 were rebuilt, while holes 9 and 12 saw some bunker work. The greens on 3, 6, 9, and 16 were reconstructed and new cart paths were installed.

Assistant Superintendent Jaret Brant can look forward to some upcoming projects: cart paths, tree work, and bunker reconstruction.

Our Host: Rick Begley

Rick Begley is a 21-year, veteran superintendent whose career includes stints at some of Philadelphia's most storied courses. But golf has been part of Rick's life since almost the very beginning. The history is best told from Rick's own perspective.

"In 1967, my Dad built a house on the 16th hole at Yardley Country Club. I have been around a golf course since I was four years old. As a kid, I used to sell iced tea and lemonade on the 16th hole. As I got older, I started cadding up the 17th hill and wading for golf balls at night selling them to the golfers. I started working at YCC when I was in 10th grade. After working hard for 32 years in the business, in May of 2008, I purchased the management contract of Middletown Country Club from my former boss."

Rick attended Rutgers University (1985-1986) and his past experience includes Yardley Country Club (1978-1988); Walnut Lane Golf Course Assistant Golf Course Superintendent, (1989-1989); John F. Byrne Golf Course (1989-1994); and Middletown Country Club (1994-Present).
